A Period of Rapid Change

Blue Mountains Wildplant Rescue Service is currently undergoing a very exciting period of change, with a new office and nursery site and a new Nursery Coordinator recently employed. These changes will provide a much greater opportunity for fundraising and contact with our members and the general public, and will help us to attain our aim of self-sufficiency for the group through the sale of rescued and propagated wildplants.

A New Home for Wildplant Rescue Service

After five and a half years in the Blackheath home of the Project Manager, the office and nursery have moved into rental premises at Clairvaux Community Centre, at 14 Oak St, Katoomba. Clairvaux is owned by the Department of Community Services and consists of four buildings on a 23 hectare site. Our office and nursery are in a building complex which also houses the Site Manager and is managed by Katoomba Neighbourhood Centre.

We are setting up a permanent sales area at Clairvaux, which will be open to the public on regular days during the week, providing us with a much higher public profile and boosting our income through sales. The new site will provide more opportunities for you, our valued members, to get involved with the office, nursery and sales activities.
